



General History and Governments of the region of Bessarabia.



Moldavia Principality, vassal of Ottoman Empire.

That region from 14 century up to May 28, 1812 was part of Moldavia Principality, and from 15 century it became a vassal of Turkey – Ottoman Empire. The south part of the region was either in direct control of Ottoman Empire or was under Jedisan horder – Tatar administration, which also was a vassal of Ottoman Empire.



Bessarabia Oblast and later Gubernia, Russia

From May 28, 1812 up to February 6, 1918 the region between rivers Prut and Dniester was under Russia's control. Southern Bessarabia – Budjak region or New Bessarabia was under Moldavia Principality/Romania control from 1856-1878. See Map of 1856.



Romania, Bessarabia Region

From April 9, 1918 – June 28, 1940 and from July 17, 1941 – August 24, 1944 (under German-Romanian occupation).



Soviet Union, part of Moldavskaya Soviet Socialist Republic and Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic

From June 28, 1940 – July 17, 1941 From August 24, 1944 to August 27, 1991.



Moldova Republic

Gain independence after collapsing of the Soviet Union on August 27, 1991.



Republic of Ukraine

Gain independence after collapsing of the Soviet Union on August 24, 1991.
