

## A Research Log to Start Research

A research log is vital to effective genealogical work, especially when dealing with brick walls. Whenever one returns to revisit their prior work, it's essential to maintain a record of the sources one has already searched, to avoid unnecessary duplication of effort. Furthermore, the process of creating and updating the log forces the genealogist to review their sources, and this scrutiny establishes a disciplined mindset and often triggers new ideas for additional sources.

Importantly, another genealogist can help you more effectively when they can see a list of the places you've already searched. The below example was a brick wall case where I had become discouraged about the prospect of ever finding any further information. However, after learning how to construct a research log, JewishGen's team of experts guided me towards a solution. In the end, we discovered far more about my ancestor than I ever thought possible.

#### Introduction

Berta BRÜLL was my great-grandmother (father's father's mother). She was born 8 Mar 1873 in Kysucké Nové Mesto, Zilina, Slovakia, according to her marriage record, but I've been unable to find her birth record. She married Salamon Samuel SPITZER on 24 Oct 1897 in Budapest, where they had three children. Berta died on 17 Dec 1919 in Budapest.

Berta's marriage record gives her parents as Jakab BRÜLL (deceased) and Jozefin POLLÓK. Her death record says Jozsef BRÜLL and Jozefa POLLÁK (both deceased). I have a death record for one Jakab BRÜLL in Budapest on 29 Jan 1893 but can't prove it is the same person (age 48 suggests birthdate about 1845 in Varín, Zilina, Slovakia). No success finding birth or marriage for Jakab or any records for Jozefin. Search in Zilina area for possible siblings yielded three possible half-siblings (mother's name different; index results only, actual records only on microfilm, awaiting response to FamilySearch Library Lookup request).

#### Goal

To understand the life of Berta BRÜLL and conclusively identify her birthplace and parents.

#### Objectives

1. Find the birth record for Berta;
2. Determine if the above Jakab is "my" Jakab;
3. Find other vital documents for Jakab/Jozsef and Jozefin/Jozefa.
