The Licensor hereby licenses the Material to JGSGB on a non exclusive basis and agrees that the material may be stored or displayed in the JGSGB Library and archives and at JGSGB's discretion at one or more of the Locations listed below. 8. The Licensor agrees that JGSGB may reformat, and if necessary, make minor editorial changes to the Material in order to meet any relevant website or publication standards.

9. Either party may terminate this Agreement by written notice if circumstances of a compelling nature arise making it essential and reasonable to do so. "Circumstances of a compelling nature" shall include by way of example only requirements and/or changes in UK legislation or charities law, best practice codes relating to data protection and/or privacy, European Community Directives and/or a serious threat of litigation that might bring JGSGB or its members into disrepute or otherwise compromise its charitable status or reputation.
