The Bristol Jewish Board of Guardians was founded in 1894 with the object of relieving the deserving poor of Bristol of the Jewish faith, whether resident or casual. The principal functions of the Board are :

- (a) To help the poor in their endeavour to earn a livelihood by gifts of money, goods, or industrial implements ; by advice ; by assistance in procuring employment ; or by any other means the Board may consider desirable.
- (b) To dispense both periodical and temporary relief ; either in money or in kind, at the discretion of the Relief Committee.
- (c) To provide assistance during sickness.
- (d) To grant loans to struggling bread winners in temporary distress.
- (e) To be the medium for dispensing private charity.

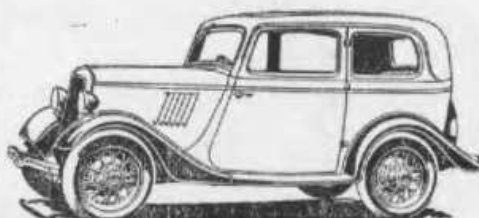
