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#### DIRECTORS REPORT

#### 1. ACTIVITIES

#### 2. TRANSFER TO/FROM RESERVES

The unrestricted funds surplus for the period of  $\pounds 2,007$  (1999: surplus  $\pounds 671$ ) has increased unrestricted reserves carried forward at 31 March 2000 to  $\pounds 7,092$ .

#### 3. STATEMENT OF DIRECTORS RESPONSIBILITIES

The directors are required to prepare the financial statements which give a true and fair view of the state of the affairs of the company and of the income and expenditure of the company for that period. In preparing those financial statements, the directors are required to:

- Select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently;

- Make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent;

- Prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the group will continue in operation.

The directors are responsible for keeping proper records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company. ## 1. STATUS
