STRICTLY FOR WOMEN

Here is an interesting way to brighten up that week-end chicken.

Chicken a la Marengo

1 Fowl
1 Tablespoon oil
1 Tablespoon chopped onion
1 Small glass white wine
 $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. flour
 $\frac{1}{2}$ Pint chicken stock
1 oz tomato purée
2 oz button mushrooms
Seasoning

Method

Boil the fowl until tender. Remove the fowl from the soup and cut into portions. Place in a pyrex dish. Fry the onion and mushrooms in the oil, in a saucepan, add the flour slowly and then the tomato purée. Add the chicken stock and wine. Season to taste. When the sauce has thickened a little, pour over the chicken.
