STRICTLY FOR WOMEN

Here is an interesting way to brighten up that week-end chicken.

Chicken a la Marengo

l Fowl
l Tablespoon oil
l Tablespoon chopped onion
l Small glass white wine
l oz. flour
l Pint chicken stock
l oz tomato purce
c oz button mushrooms
Seasoning

Mothod

Boil the fowl until tender. Remove the fewl from the soup and cut into portions. Place in a pyrex dish. Fry the onion and mushrooms in the oil, in a saucepan, add the flour slowly and then the tomato purec. Add the chicken stock and wine. Season to taste. When the sauce has thickened a little, pour over the chicken.
