It is with great regret that we have to report the death of Mr. I. Freeland, who passed away suddenly a few days before his 88th birthday. The funeral actually took place on his birthday. Mr. Freeland has been a valued member of the Congregation for many years. In the past he held several honorary positions, including that of Registrar, besides being our Hon. Treasurer as well as Secretary at a later stage of his long service to the Congregation. He served during the first World War in H.M. Forces, and was a founder member of the Polack Branch of the Royal British Legion. In this Branch he served for over twenty years as Treasurer, and was our representative at County Headquarters for more years than one can remember. His record of attendance was unsurpassed, he missed only one meeting in all these years, and that was the one before he passed away.

Mr. Freeland came from Scotland, but was regarded as a Bristolian through his long residence and service to those who knew him. His Son, who left years ago to live and work in Rome, flew to Bristol to arrange and attend the funeral. We express our deepest sympathy to him and his family.

The funeral was attended by relatives and friends. The Royal British Legion was represented by Captain J. Davis.

Mr. Freeland will be missed by all those who have been associated with him during his lifetime.
