We understand that there are a number of Jewish boys at Millfield School, Street, Somerset and we have been asked if it would be possible to send a Tutor to give instruction on Sunday mornings during chapel time, as we do at a number of Public Schools such as Eton, Harrow and Rugby.

The distance is too far for anyone to go from London and it is therefore necessary to find a suitable Tutor with a car say within an hour and a half's car journey from Millfield. Mr. Levy thought you might possibly know someone who would be prepared to undertake it. An adequate fee and all expenses will, of course, be paid.


