A report from our Representative to the Board of Deputies, Mr. Dennis Jacobs, was read to Members of Council at the last Council Meeting on January 24th. A copy of this report can be obtained from the Secretary, or the Editors. The following is an extract:

"Disused Cemeteries. A Charitable Trust is to be established to raise funds to improve the conditions of the sacred grounds. Perhaps you would let me know if there are any such Cemeteries in the Bristol Area which need attention and are not receiving such.

Philip Gannaway, Chairman of the N.F.'s Bristol Branch, and a member of the Front for 9 years, has resigned following a visit to Rome where he heard the late Pope John Paul I address an audience of pilgrims. The 'moving experience' convinced him that he could no longer be associated with the party's anti-semitic and racist views.
