MESSAGE FOR PURIM 1979/5739.

With the announcement of the month of Adar we are looking forward to celebrating this most wonderful Festival of PURIM. It is a day which we are spending in joyful thankfulness for the deliverance of the Jewish People from great danger. It brings back to our memory the great historical event over 2000 years ago described in the book of ESTHER when the Jewish People of Persia have been condemned by Haman, a descendant of the people of AMALEK, to be exterminated, but who have been saved by the dramatic actions of the great heroes Queen ESTHER and MORDECAI.

Recent events in Persia are reminding us on the known phrase "History Repeats Itself". It seems that the new leaders of Persia are following the pattern of their former AMALEKITES agitators with their dangerous activities not only for the Jews in Persia, but also for the State of Israel.
