Families are sitting round the glittering Sedertable with all the traditional tasty dishes placed on the Seder plate. We are reciting the most popular book, the HAGGADAH, bringing back to our memory the thousands of years ago enslavement of the Jewish people in Egypt and their final redempotion. But this great event of the Brethrens has an important meaning for us in our present time because the Jewish People have proclaimed to the nations of the world FAITH is the fundamental principle of human existence.
