The President, MR. I. KUSHNER in his report, expressed his pride in being associated, in his final year in office, with one of the most important period of the Community's history, and hoped that all the hard work and fund-raising, culminating in the creation of the FRANK COHEN HALL, and our newly renovated Synagogue, would benefit not only the present, but future congregations. Mr. Kushner paid tribute to the memory of Mr. Frank Cohen, whose generous legacy to the Bristol Community, was the prime mover in launching the project, and to the many people who gave unstintingly of their time and money. He expressed the hope, that as a result of the great effort, there would be improved Synagogue attendance, more involvement with the Student body, and all possible support of future functions in the new Hall.

Mr. Kushner also paid tribute to MR. ALAN TOBIAS and his Colleagues, who, with REV. MODDEH, are running our TALMUD TORAH to the highest possible standards. He projected the hope that his successor would receive the same close support from Executive, Council, and Members in the coming year-as PHASE 2 is tackled, as he himself had enjoyed.

At the A.G.M. a Resolution was passed postponing discussion on the AMENDMENTS to the CONSTITUTION. These will now be circulated in writing to ALL MEMBERS shortly for their comments, after which a further EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING will again be called-TO WHICH ALL MEMBERS ARE URGED TO ATTEND.

A resolution proposing an increase in Membership Subscription to £100 per year (pro-rata for single members etc.), was passed.
