A.J.E.X. work very closely with the Board of Deputies in monitoring and controlling any incidents that occur.

On WEDNESDAY JANUARY 27th, 1962 a meeting is to be held at the house of Sam Silverman, 36 C. Beale Court Downend at 8pm. where a few very prominent members of A.J.E.X. are coming to Bristol to advise US on the action to take should any Bristolians be involved in any Anti Semitic incidents.

THIS MEETING IS MOST IMPORTANT and must be well attended. We are very fortunate to have escaped some of the problems of other large provincial cities and we hope we never will be involved but we MUST BE PREPARED.


