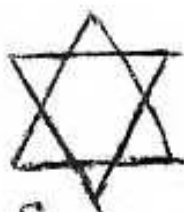

LABOUR FRIENDS OF ISRAEL

Councillor Tom Turvey J.P. presided; and the Top Table included Lord Brooks, Arthur Palmer M.P.; Mike Cocks M.P. (Chief Labour Whip) and David Seligman of Cardiff. (Apologies for absence from Tony Benn M.P.)

Lord Brooks gave an outstanding address on the Middle East situation stressing the needs and justice for Israel. For myself it was a moving experience to be among so many non Jewish people, enthusiastic for our cause - especially when, in addition to the Loyal Toast, everyone drank to 'THE STATE OF ISRAEL'.
