OBITUARY

Mr. Albert Polack, whose death in Bristol is announced, was one of the Clifton College housemasters who made a unique contribution to English public school education. He was 90.

Clifton College is the only public school with a house, Polack, especially for boys of the Jewish faith.

Albert Polack, succeeded his father Joe, in 1923, and remained housemaster until 1949.

He was a prominent figure in Anglo-Jewry, and when he retired from Clifton, spent the next 22 years as education officer for the Council of Christian and Jews.

A Memorial Service was held in the Synagogue at Clifton College.
