Bert: Sacof the other sister, has served on the Bristol Education Committee for nearly the years. Among many important offices, she is a Governor of Red Heids School, and Chairman of the Bristol Central Commercial School. Youth work is among her special interests. Mrs B. Sacof had the honour of being appointed Justice of the Peace in 1951 - being the first Jewish person for many years to be a Magistrate.
