KOL NIDRE APPEAL 5744/1983

Dear Colleagues,

This Yom Kippur will mark the tenth anniversary of the outbreak of the war which tragically transferred the very words "Yom Kippur" from the Hebrew Calendar to the international vocabulary, and from prayers for life to mourning for death.

In our Kol Nidre Appeal this year we might well remind our congregants of the many families in Israel who will recite Kaddish on this and the following days for their dear ones fallen in their gallant defence of Israel.

We who are mercifully spared this Kaddish, and the sacrifice of our children for Israel's security, should at least feel roused by their agony and rally to support Israel by the incomparably happier contribution of our material help to demonstrate our solidarity and to relieve Israel's crushing burdens in partnership with Zion's heroic sons and daughters.

This demonstration of our identification with the cause of Israel is all more vital at the end of a year full of tribulations, including further heavy losses of life and attempts by our detractors to drive a wedge between Israel and the Diaspora.

I trust, that no Jew will stand aside or shirk his and her responsibility to make manifest the unity of the House of Israel and the determination to secure the peace and well being of Zion's children through our wholehearted support to this year's Kol Nidre Appeal.

With fervent hope that our prayers and actions may make us worthy of speedy Redemption.
