Those of you who pay Income Tax can help even more by taking a Covenant to pay a certain amount over more than 3 years, whereby tax can be recovered to increase your contribution by 43%, at no extra cost to you. Ask our representative when he or she calls on you for the appropriate form.

Your help in this will be greatly appreciated in Israel and by your local committee.
