MESSAGE FOR THE NEW YEAR 1984/5745

Strengthened by the warmth of sunshine during the Summer period, we are preparing ourselves with the solemn season of the YAMIN NORAIM of the High Festivals of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. These two Festivals represent some of the most basic beliefs of the Jewish Faith. On Rosh Hashanah G'd is acknowledged as King of the Iniverse who sits in judgement over all his creatures. On Yom Kippur man seeks G'd through repentance and receives his pardon and full atonements.
