Although like so many of us, Sidney did not have the good fortune to be born in Bristol, he showed his interest from the beginning by being born in Praed St, Paddington, as close as one could possibly get to Bristol in the railway age. By marrying one of the Strimer Sisters he demonstrated his attachment to the City and the careing side of his life.
