BRISTOL J.I.A. CAMPAIGN 1986

Thanks to the generosity of the loyal few who attended the launching of the 1986 appeal by Dr Meron Medzini, the Campaign got off to a good start. The people who missed a most interesting evening, will, we hope, help bring the campaign to a good end.

Dr. Medzini, who is Director of the Leadership Development division of Kere Hayesod is a academic who has held several important posts in the Hebrew University and in Politics. He was spokesman for Premiers Pshkol Meir and Rabin, so he speaks with some authority..

He told us how the rate of inflation in Israel has been reduced to a compounded 40% a year, at the end of 1984 it was running at 800% a year.

He went on to tell us how the need for our contributions still remains high. The Ethiopians are still being brought in, and those who came during operation Moses need housing and educating. It is a continuing saga. Project Renewal is being extended to encompass the Northern Territories, like Kiryat Shmona and the Moshavim on the Lebanese border, all need support, and it is people like us who can give. I'm sorry that so few people attended the meeting, those who didn't, in fact THOSE WHO NEEDED TO RECEIVE THE MESSAGE, missed a very instructive and worthwhile evening.

We shall then do our best to put them in contact with a new friend, but, of course, must stress this may take time if we do not have anyone suitable. If they care to send a picture this would also be welcome.
