MESSAGE FOR PASSOVER 1986 / 5746

 We are looking forward to celebrate the wonderful Festival of PESACH which plays a very important part in our Jewish literature. Since it is called "Z'MAN CHEIRUTEINU" "THE SEASON OF OUR FREEDOM" we find the EXODUS from Egypt mentioned as the first of the TEN COMMANDMENTS also at the KIDDUSH on SHABBAT and FESTIVALS.

The significance of the great historical event of the departure from Egypt is also stated in two Chapters from the book of EXODUS placed in the box of TEFILLIN.

There is no other event in the Jewish Calendar which needs so much preparation as the Festival of PESACH. Very soon we are getting ready for our celebration at the SEDER nights. We are sitting in a festive mood round our SEDER table joined by our relatives and friends with the various kind of special dishes on our SEDER plate. We are explaining to our children the meaning of our PASSOVER celebration and stressing to them the importance that the History of the redemption of the Jewish People from Egypt has its great message to us in our present time as we are reciting it in our HAGGADAH with the following words;

"FOR IT WAS NOT OUR ANCESTORS ALONE THAT THE HOLY ONE, BLESSED BE HE, REDEEMED, HE ALSO DELIVERED US WITH THEM"

By celebrating our SEDER in the old traditional way, we are encouraging our children with the spiritual SEDER of our JUDAISM, and we are bringing near the time when Jewish People will be able to live their free life even in those Countries where they are still enslaved.

Dear Mr. Adler,

While in England recently I read your letter in the J.C. and not having any contacts within the Jewish Community in Bristol, am writing to you for advice.

In October 1986, DR. YEHUDA GILL will be coming to Bristol for a one year MSc Course in Oral Medicine at the Dental School. DR. GILL is a Graduate of the Hebrew University, Hadassah School of Dentistry in Jerusalem and has been with us for four years, working in the Department of Oral Surgery.

We are keen on his getting additional training in Oral Medicine as he has agreed to stay on with us to run a DENTAL UNIT for MEDICALLY COMPROMISED PATIENTS. This unit is of PRIME IMPORTANCE in this medically neglected Region, and we intend to open it in the near future.

DR. GILL will have to finance his course which will cost him £7,500, his travel expenses and his Board and Lodging.

You probably know Hospital pay here is very poor, and he intends to sell his car, etc. to enable him to carry out his endeavour.

We are a peripheral government hospital, far from the medical showcases in the centre of the country. We have no public relations organizations to help support us, and find it extremely difficult to get scholarships.

I was wondering if the Jewish Community in Bristol could possibly help Dr. Gill get through his year in Bristol. He will be coming with his wife and baby, and any advice or help with his accommodation would be most welcome.

I hope you did not find this letter too tiresome, but I would like to help him, just as he has shown a willingness to stay in the Galilee to help us improve our Services to the very deserving Public of this most vital Region.
