TALMUD TORAH

The TALMUD TORAH Summer Term has now ended.Over the last few years the number of pupils on the register has fallen as a result of the older children leaving without a significant new intake.When the new term resumes on SUNDAY ,SEPTEMBER 7TH. 1986 there will be 8 pupils only attending classes.

With such small numbers it is not economically viable to run two full classes as during this last year.From a practical point of view it would be extremely difficult to run a single class because of the disparity in both age and ability. After much discussion it was concluded that the optimum solution to this problem is to have a session with two groups for reading practice,Berachot and Translation,followed by a session with all pupils for Festivals,religious knowledge and history.The range of ages and abilities will be less critical for this latter session.

In order to put this into practice there will be one "full-time" Teacher (myself)and one "part-time" Teacher to assist with the reading session. I am happy to report that BENCIE WOLL has agreed to take on the "part-time" duties.Because of the new arrangements,EMMANUEL AHARONI has now "retired" after some 5 years teaching.Every Sunday he has undertaken an 80 mile round trip from Cheltenham in order to teach in our Classes.On some occasions he has even made the journey when his son Daniel was ill or unable to attend. On behalf of the Talmud Torah Committee,and the parents of his many pupils, I would like to express my sincerest thanks to EMMANUEL for his efforts during the past 5years. His dedication and commitment have helped the Talmud Torah run smoothly and successfully during this time.

Finally,because of the smaller classes it will be necessary to increase subscriptions next term With effect from September 7th. 1986 these will be £1.50 per pupil per week.
