## HI-TECH REACHES BRITISH/JEWISH COMMUNITY

Hi-technoligy has at last reached the Jewish community of Britain. The Zionist Federation is the imaginative organisation to make use for the first time of such modern facilities as a communication satellite.

The sattelite will be used when Israel's Prime Minister SHIMON PERES, will appear live from Jerusalem, via satellite, to address a large gathering in London. The meeting will be held on Thursday October 2nd. at 7.30 in the large hall of Friends House, Euston Road, London. The hall helds almost 1,000 people.

Prime Minister Peres will make a short opening statement and will then answer questions put to him by people from the floor of the hall. Questions can be submitted in advance to the Zionist Federation and a panel will choose the best ones without knowing who the questionnaires were. Those selected to ask questions will be asked to come to the meeting and sit near the microphones.
