# SECURITY

The Security Officers of the Synagogue would like to thank all those members who took turns to look after the main gate during the Yom Tovim Services.

Security is a matter we cannot take lightly. We know it is impossible with our limited resources to mount a full scale observation of the whole of our premises. It is for this reason that we ask all members who are attending services—and on other occasions—to bear in mind the following:

- 1. LEAVE THE PREMISES QUICKLY. DO NOT CONGREGATE OUTSIDE.
- 2.DO NOT BRING PARCELS TO THE SYNAGOGUE
- 3. KEEP A GENERAL WATCH ON ALL THAT IS HAPPENING AS YOU APPROACH AND LEAVE THE VICINITY OF THE SYNAGOGUE.
- 4. REPORT ANY SUSPICIOUS HAPPENINGS.

We hope and pray that there will be no terrorist activity anywhere. While we think Bristol to be a low risk area, we must nevertheless adopt a responsible attitude, and not lull ourselves into thinking that NO Security is needed. Let us think of it as an insurance policy-we must have it, but hope we never need it.
