MESSAGE FOR CHANUCAH 1986/5747

In the midst of the dark months of the Winter Season, when nature in the outside world seems to hold their winter sleep, we Jewish People are celebrating CHANUCAH, the most popular Festival in the Jewish Calender. It's historical event goes back over two thousand years ago, when the Jewish People in the Holy Land were fighting a battle for religeous Freedom against the Military Empire of Antiochus Epiphanes, King of Syria. The Jews were forbidden to carry out their religious observances, and were commanded to worship the idol of a Greek god placed upon the Alter of the TEMPLE.

It was a small group of Jews under the leadership of MATFATHIAS and his five sons in Medin, who started the revolt against the dictatorship of Antiochus. JUDAH MACCABEE who succeeded his Father, brought great honour to the Jewish People in gaining possession of the TEMPLE after his successful battles against the Syrians. The lights of the MENORAH were Kindled by the consecrated oil which unexpectedly lasted for eight days. The lights of the MENORAH are a vivid reminder of the heroism of the MACCABEANS in challenging the might of a great empire. Their supreme courage as Defenders of the Faith

has illuminated the pages of our history. We have been witnessing in a recent event, that it was again Syria which was involved in a terrorist action against a substantial number of people who were on their flight to the Land of Israel. In a miraculous way they have been saved by Divine Protection. Our modern MACCABEAN in Israel have been inspired by those great MACCABEANS of old, by the great sacrifices they have shown to safeguard the Jewish People since the establishment of the Jewish State. They will continue with the great task to revive the old spirit of CHANUCAH by keeping the traditional light of the TORAH burning.

Let us hope that the CHANUCAH LIGHTS which we are kindling in our homes, and which are illuminating the cities of ISPAEL, bring new light to the people of Israel and to the world at large to have permenant peace and security. It will then be fulfilled what we are saying in our daily prayers
