THE CYRIL EPSTEIN TRUST ESTABLISHED IN LOVING MEMORY  
OF HIS PARENTS FLI AND EVA EPSTEIN

Cyril Epstein has given a property, namely 24 Cotham Hill, Bristol to the trustees to hold on behalf of the three charities of his choice as a permanent endowment.

The three beneficiaries are the Bristol Hebrew Congregation as to 2/5s, the Bristol Chevra Kadisha 1/5th, and the Cardiff Old Age Home 1/5th. There is a condition that the Epstein family graves are fully maintained, and the capital is not to be spent, but only the income from the property may be paid to the three beneficiaries.

The property at Cotham Hill is currently let and the December rent will be due to the beneficiaries though some of the initial rent will be lost in the initial expenses of setting up the trust.

Cyril has appointed Len Gould, Arnold Greenwood and Colin Berkovitch as the first trustees of the fund.
