Despite the release of COLONEL LEV OVSISCHER-one of the first "refuseniks" and IDA NUDEL; despite the benefits of "glasnost", which has seen the number of exit permits rise to over 5000 since January as against fewer than 1000 last year; 385000 Jews wish to leave the USSR, and their fate is still the cause of increasing concern.

On a recent visit, VIVIAN JOFFE was able to meet several refusnik families, and has agreed to invite members of WIZO, their husbands and any other . interested friends to her home ar Chatford House, The Promenade, Clifton, on TUESDAY 24th. November at 8 oo p.m to give a first hand report of her findings, illustrated by slides.

We make no apolagy for charging £1 per person admission(which will include refreshments!!) for this event.WIZO operations in Israel are in dire strats due to Gevernment cutbacks, and we must take every opportunity at all times to add to our fund raising efforts.
