On a recent visit,VIVIAN JOFFE was able to meet several refusenik families, and has agreed to invite members of WIZO,their husbands and any other interested friends to her home at Chatford House,The Promenade,Clifton,on TUESDAY 24th. November at 8.00 p.m to give a first hand report of her findings,illustrated by slides.

We make no apology for charging £1 per person admission(which will include refreshments!!) for this event.WIZO operations in Israel are in dire straits due to Government cutbacks,and we must take every opportunity at all times to add to our fund raising efforts.
