HUSBANDS AND FRIENDS WELCOME

The Jewish Community in Liverpool, was, as far back as I can remember, really centred around one main street, Brownlon Hill. Off it were the small streets, Leander, Pomuna, Shannon and Great Newton, which strike me now as famous historical names, really too proud to represent the grubby terraced houses that made up these streets.

Brownlon Hill was the shopping centre even though the actual "town" was five minutes away at the bottom of the hill. This was the main Jewish 'ghetto' of the 1920's. Families and 'Landsleit'-people from the same town in East Europe, huddled together, sharing their joys and sorrows together. Intermarriage of families was common, so that among the elders of one's family, were one's friends-oh yes! there 'berdigessen'-(spats), even over a game of solo on a Saturday night, a feud would start, if only short-lived.

But the day we would all look forward to, was Sunday if the sun shone. That was when the women would busily make sandwiches of Cholla or black bread, and there would be an exodus to New Brighton, with, literally, its golden beaches, before the word "pollution" was ever invented. The routine was, Tram(with the excitement of upper decks), to the Pier Head. Then the famous ferry to Egremont, and then New Brighton. There, as we docked and came off the boat, would be the one-legged diver, who would dive off the pier-40-50 ft. down, and somebody would be there to collect money for his heroic deed. It was one way of earning a living.

Once off the boat, everyone bought tickets from a machine-1d. for children 2d.for adults, through the turnstiles, and on to the beach. There it was our job to dig a shallow hole out of the sand with niches for seats for parents, who would sit aroun and reminisce of the old days in 'der haim'.

We would either build ourselves ingenious sandcastles, or boats or cars and pretend to speed away on the Mersey to anywhere. If we were lucky and had a ball we played cricket or football or rounders. The more adventurous clambered among the rocks looking for crabs,or even fish. No pollution remember! Came tea time, we had a choice no cafe's for us, we could not afford it-our parents would take us to a barn like place on the promenade, or to a park. Here the procedure was the same. The fathers would go to the counter, hand over some tea in a bag, and ask for a pot of hot waterfor sixpence and a shilling deposit, the people behind the counter, would, with your tea, fill the pot with hot water, with a jug, and as many sups and saucers as you needed-and hey presto-you had an alfresco tealI can remember even after the war going through all this with my kids, and most likely this still goes on at some seaside resorts. Then came the time to go home-back to the ferry boat where queues had formed to get on. The children, once aboard, would roam wide-eyed around the ship looking at the for them massive engines or even for bullet holes, because these same ferry boats had taken part in the attack on Zeebrugge. Many a time did we enac what we thought happened there. Then, off the boats to form more queues for trams, then home wearily for a quick supper and bed. Simple pleasures, but how deeply enjoy Majorca, Spain Never heard of them, except in Geography class. Those were the days! The kids invented their own worlds and dreamed their limited dreams-but boy were w HAPPY!!
