Why is this meeting necessary?

We believe that many of us feel the time is right to evaluate and analyse where we stand as women in our Orthodox community today. **Not** to bring about change as an exercise in Jewish Women's Lib, but as a chance to air such issues as the opportunity for us to gain a greater understanding of the services and of Hebrew, perhaps through organising a "Synagogue Survival Course"; for a woman to comment in shul on the Sedra of the week; and for the younger generation of women to be encouraged to take part in readings alongside their male friends.

It is unlikely we will come out of any single meeting with answers or proposals, but it should be a stimulating and exciting hour or so, in which we can share together our thoughts and opinions in an atmosphere of mutual respect.

An exhibition of photocollages and poems
by Marta Valls and Dan Hershon

This exhibition is a collaboration between Spanish artists Marta Valls and Bristol poet Dan Hershon. Born in Catalonia, Marta Valls is a photographer and artist, who combines images and treats the result, to create her own original works. Many of the pictures on display are illustration of the Spanish poet Juan Salvat-Papasseit, taken from a collection of love poetry el poema de la rosa als llavis (The poem of the rose on the lips). The translations into English are by Dan Hershon, who works full time as a poet. He is currently Secretary of the Avon Poetry Festival and as a graduate in modern languages from Edinburgh University is here able to reflect a combination of interests and skills. Alongside the Spanish works are a number of recent illustrations to original poems by Dan Hershon. Marta and Dan will be publishing their first collection of poetry and photocollages in the New Year.
