Name of person or body entitled to appoint trustees (council members): The membership in general meeting of Finchley Progressive Synagogue.

Structure, Governance and Management: The Synagogue's governing document is its constitution. The Trustees are its Council Members. They meet regularly throughout the year and there are sub-committees and groups, which report to council. In addition the Synagogue employs administrative staffs who are responsible for the management of the building, day to day finances and co-ordination of activities. All significant operational decisions are made by Council, with certain key decisions approved by the membership in open meeting.

Objects of the charity: To advance religion in accordance with the beliefs and tenets and doctrines of Liberal Judaism. The Synagogue is a member of Liberal Judaism, for which benefit affiliation fees are payable.

2. Activities and Achievements.

Under the direction of its Rabbi the synagogue end its members continue to provide religious, cultural and communal facilities and to support to members and their families during the year.

Rabbi Rebecca Qassim Birk has led the community throughout the year ably supported by Assistant Rabbi Rene Pfertzel and Synagogue manager, Pauline Gusack.

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3. Grant making Policy

The Synagogue pursues its charitable giving through a number of programmes, such as the High Holy Day Appeal and voluntary subscription levies.

4. Accounts

The accounts for 2014 are presented within this report. The trustees are advised, by their accountants, that no audit is required this year. The trustees confirm that the accounts and the notes thereto comply with current statutory requirements, the requirements of the synagogue's constitution and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice for Charities (Revised 2005).

There was a net surplus of unrestricted funds for the year of £5,472 (2013: £14,570 deficit). Total income increased by £3,067 (2013: increased by £844).

Total Expenditure decreased by £16,577, which in part was due to a reduction in repair costs and the absence of costs incurred in 2013 associated with the 60th Anniversary celebrations.

At 31 December 2014 the synagogue held unrestricted funds of £388,223 (2013: £382,751) and restricted funds of £125,733 (2013: £117,900). The Board believes the financial position remains stable and will continue to monitor costs carefully throughout a continuing difficult period in the economy.

The Funeral fund holds an asset comprising a loan of £42,000 (2013: £50,000) made to Liberal Judaism to facilitate the expansion of the Edgwarebury Lane Cemetery. A staged repayment of £8,000 of this loan was received during the year.

5. Reserves Policy

It is the policy of the Synagogue to maintain unrestricted funds at a level which is sufficient to keep the Synagogue solvent. In conjunction with the subscriptions and other income resources this provides sufficient funds to cover administrative and support costs.

6. Risk Assessment

The trustees confirm they have considered the major risks to which the synagogue is exposed, as identified by the trustees, that they have reviewed these and consider that appropriate systems have been established to mitigate those risks.

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7. Public Benefit

The trustees confirm they have complied with their duty to have due regard to the guidance on public benefit in exercising their powers and duties.

8. Approval

The trustees (Council Members) have approved the trustees' report.

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST DECEMBER 2014

1 Principal accounting policies

Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities and with the Charities Act 2011. In preparing the financial statements the charity follows best practice as laid down in the Statement of Recommended Practice Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2011).

Resources expended

Expenditure is included on an accruals basis.

Tangible fixed assets

All assets, other than consumables and items under £5,000, are capitalised. Depreciation is not charged on freehold land and buildings. Furniture and equipment is written down on a straight-line basis over their estimated useful life at the rate of 25% per annum, however

no depreciation has been charged in the current year as Council considers it to be written down to net realisable value.

Fund accounting

Details and the nature and purpose of each restricted fund are set out in note 9.

Recognition of incoming resources and liabilities

Subscriptions are included in the Statement of Financial Activities (Sofa) upon receipt. Grants and donations are included in the Sofa, when the charity has unconditional entitlement. Tax reclaims are included in the Sofa at the same time as Gift Aid claims are submitted. Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out resources.
